Outcome

Own book retelling The parable of The Prodigal Son

Rationale

We would like our learners to become familiar with some of the parables in the New Testament and their purpose and meanings. In order to do this, they are going to explore several parables and retell them using drama, role play, story maps and sequencing. In order to broaden and deepen their learning and understanding, we are going to give opportunities to consider how these parables are relevant to life today and how their principles can influence our behaviour and relationships with others.
