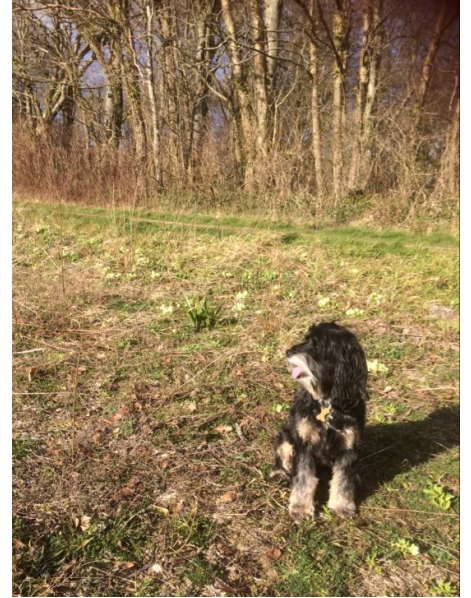


Hello Merley,
